Map of Indonesia



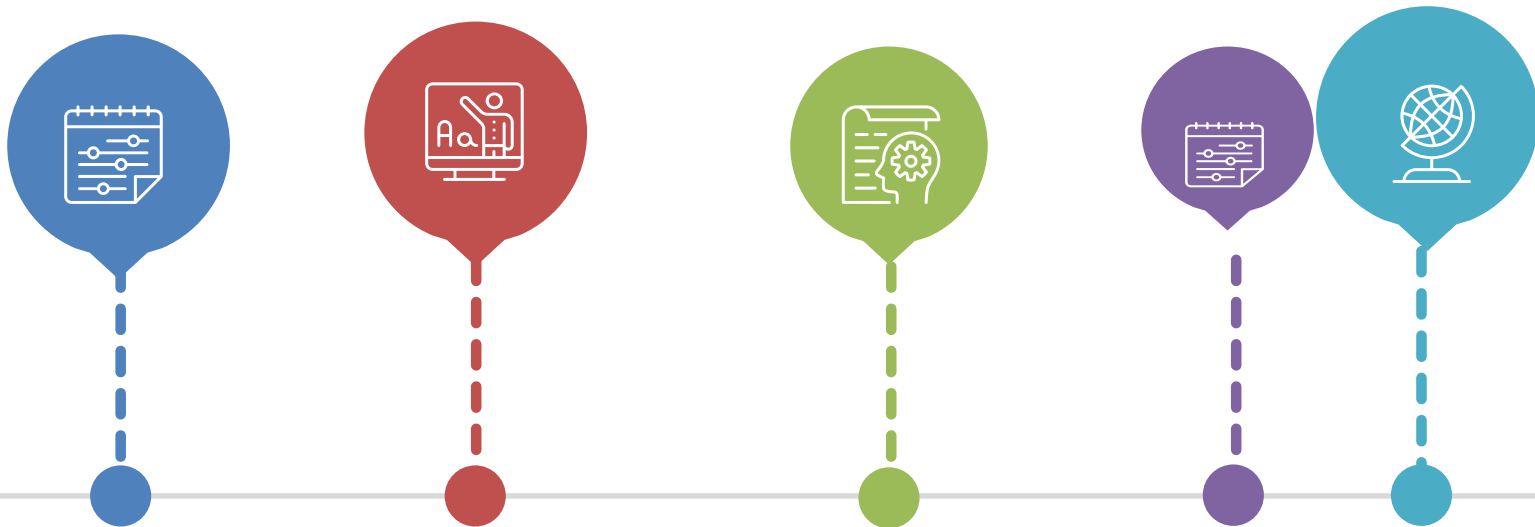
Map of Sulawesi island

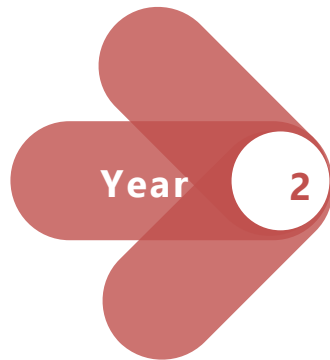

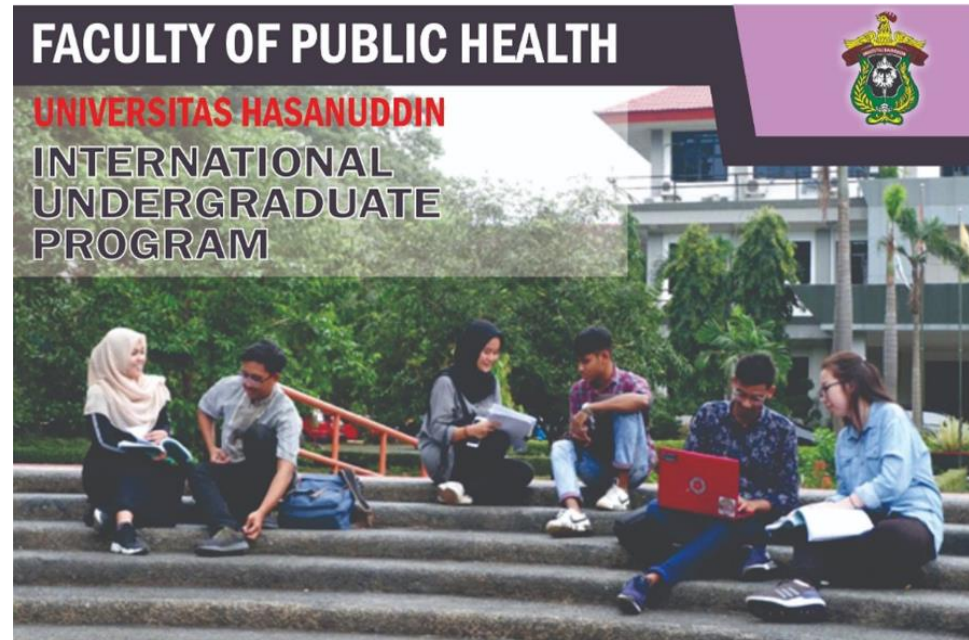
Students and Lecturers
