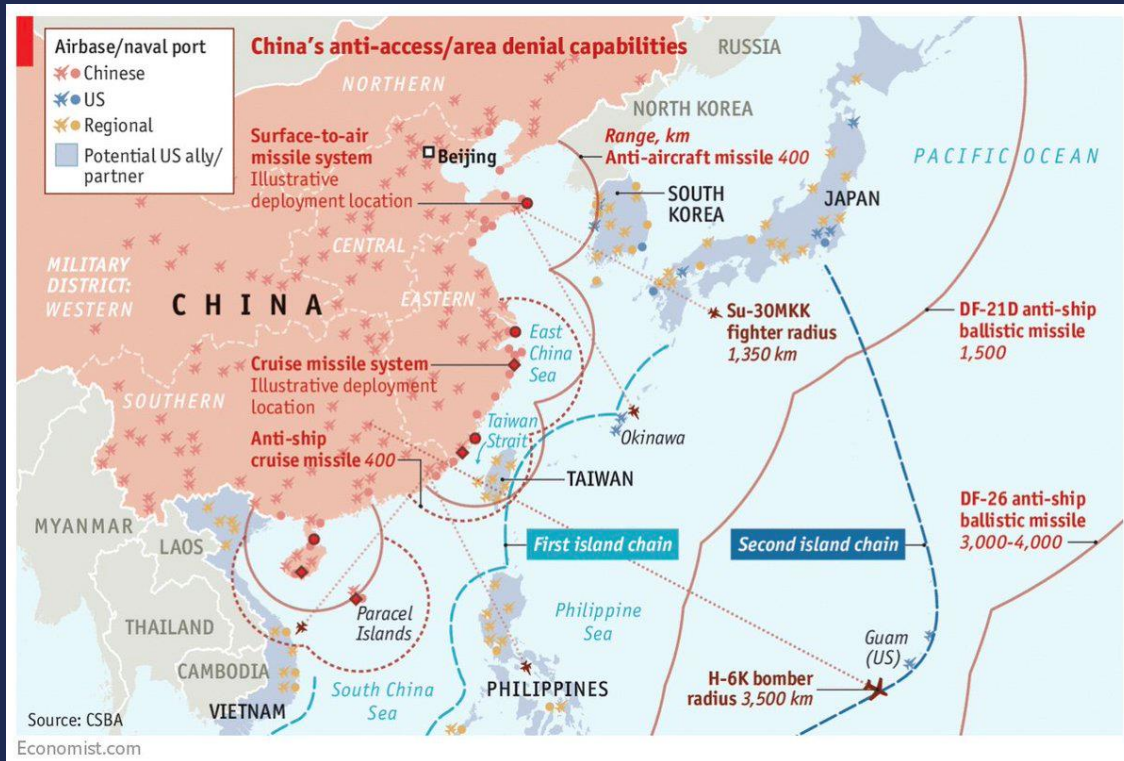

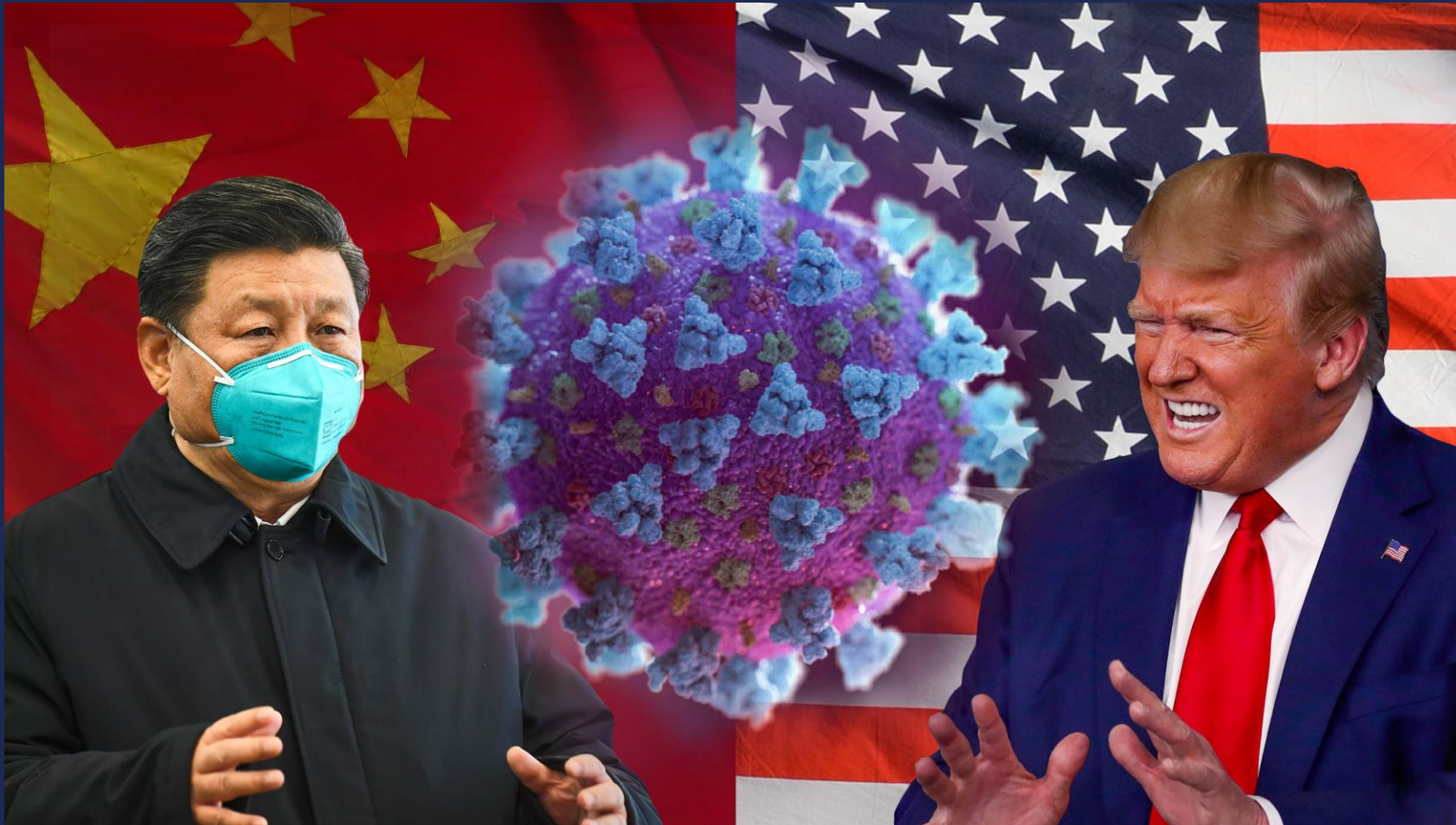

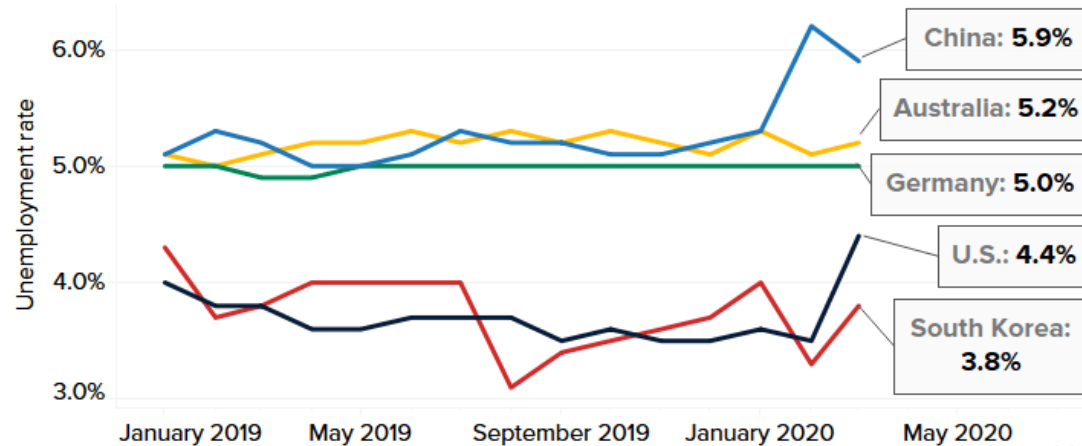

Lines show unemployment rates in selected economies

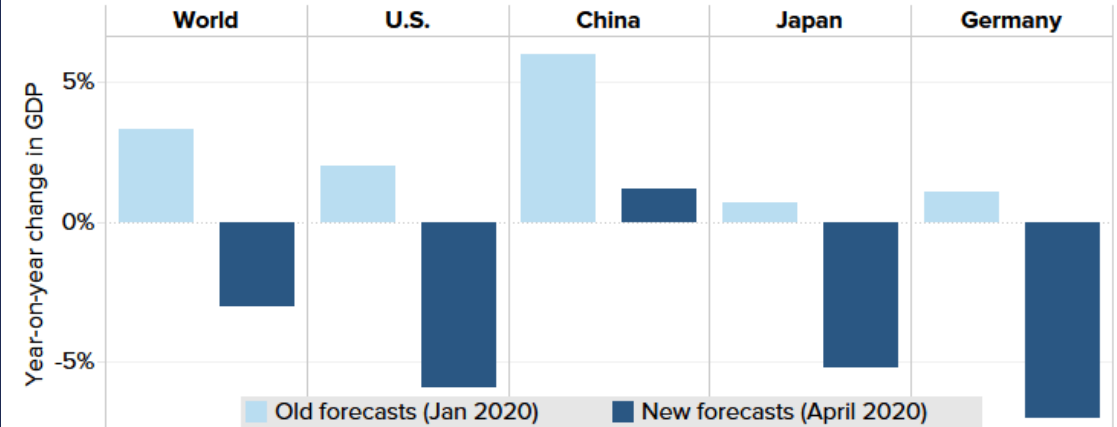
